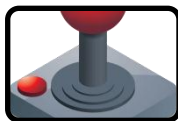

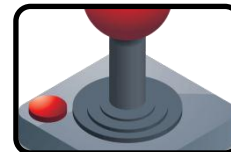
About Codemasters

AREAS OF CONCERN

- Pre-Purchase & DRM Notification

DRM: SecuROM documentation absent from Publisher's websites, Gaming Package, Manual, Readme and EULA.

Publisher: As above; Delayed release; Delayed demo release.

- EULA

DRM: EULA absent from Sony DADC.

Publisher: As above; Written based on UK laws; Incomprehensible and inconsistent; No warranties/refunds provisions for consumers outside UK; Ownership bias; Internal Disputes Resolution non-existent.

- Personal Backup

BOTH: Not permissible as per EULA and DRM implemented.

- Installation

DRM: SecuROM Files not contained to Gaming Directory; Installation logs not provided.

Publisher: As above; Installation logs not provided; No mention of additional software (Mission Editor) in the Gaming Package, Manual, Readme and EULA.

- Activation

DRM: Hardware activation; Disc required to play OF:DR; Resale prohibited.

Publisher: As above.

- Manual Game Patches & Updates

DRM: No notification of partial DRM removal; No changelogs provided on the official support website.

Publisher: As above; Changelogs provided after installation; Forced installation of additional software (Mission Editor); Cannot roll back to previous version if errors arise.

- Uninstallation

DRM: DRM Removal tool not provided in game; Some files and registry keys remain.

Publisher: As above; Uninstallation link not provided.

- Customer / Technical Support

DRM: None provided on Codemasters Technical Support page (Based on no notification as evaluated)

Publisher: As above; Common technical issues not tagged or updated on the Support page.
