## About Prince of Persia (2008)

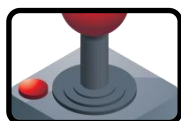

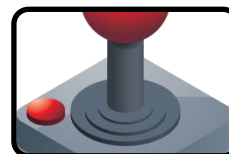
